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Cry of the unborn before abortion:

"Our cry roars to the mountains. No one perceives it. Our struggle for life begins. How foolish the doctors are. Everything revolves around the mother. Her will is our way of passing away, although our Almighty Father wanted to give us life. Who listens to Him? Who believes Him? Who prays to Him?

And it begins: We tremble. We cry out. We fall silent. It is time. Ultrasound. The injection. The dismemberment. Out we come in a torn state.

Who can atone for that?

Jesus takes the guilt upon Himself. "Through Him we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." (Col 1:13) In Holy Confession we are offered His atoning sacrifice.

6 steps after an abortion (Jean Pliya)

- 1) Confess the sin; ask God's forgiveness for not accepting the gift of a child; repent in order to "make reparation".
- 2) Ask a knowledgeable priest to cut the bondage to the spirit of death.
- 3) Give the child a first name.
- 4) Ask the child's forgiveness for the hurt caused by rejection or for the denial of a dignified burial.

- 5) Pray for the child's "healing" and for one's own inner healing; tell the child that one loves him/her and wants to accept him/her as a gift from God and thus give him/her life.
- 6) Have a Holy Mass read and participate in it to thank God for the child and give it back to Him in freedom.

Prayer during Holy Mass (Jean Pliya)

The life of each person is in your hands, O Jesus. And you have said, "Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me;." (Mt 18:5)

I now accept the child You have given me; I receive him or her in Your love and declare that I love him or her as You love him or her. I receive it into my womb as a great gift from You, that it may grow there, month by month, until its birth. I want to give it life so that it may be happy. I give you back this beloved child. I surrender it to Your Mother, My Mother and his or her Mother, the Virgin Mary, at the foot of Your Cross, so that she may place it in Your wounded side, in Your Sacred Heart, O Jesus. Lord, rich in mercy, heal me and free my spirit completely from all tormenting memory and wounds. Please heal all the wounds of my child's rejection. Take away from it all influences of the spirit of death. Shower it with Your peace and joy, that it may rejoice in You forever. Amen.

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
